

Travel Grants for PhD Candidates (f, d)

Dear PhD Candidates (f, d),

I would like to draw your attention to the current round of **travel funding for female PhD candidates** in computer science provided by the Equal Opportunity Commission. The goal of this travel funding is to enable (new) female PhD candidates to attend a scientific event (conference, workshop, summer school) relevant to their dissertation area **even WITHOUT their own contribution**. This aims particularly at fostering early networking opportunities.

Application

If you are interested, please submit your application with the following documents/information:

- **Motivation letter:** approx. 1 page, including a brief description of your research area and a justification for attending the event
- **Travel information:** Conference & location, estimated costs
- **Supervision Agreement:** with at least one supervising person from the Institute of Computer Science of the University of Würzburg
- **Short CV**

Please send your application as a **single PDF document** to

no later than on the **15th of March** or the **15th of September** of the respective calendar year.

Please note that the budget of the Equal Opportunity Commission is limited, so multiple lower-cost trips may be prioritized over a single more expensive one. At the same time, we understand, of course, that certain renowned international conferences have accordingly high fees and are regularly held overseas. Funding is primarily intended to support participation in a conference without presenting one's own contribution. If an applicant plans to present or has submitted a contribution, the application must specify the type of contribution and its acceptance status or likelihood of acceptance.
