COURSES AVAILABLE

Our studies are organised in 4 years on Undergraduate (Bachelor) studies and 2 years on Masters. Besides, there are 15 specialised Masters currently offered at the Faculty.

All courses are taught in Spanish and are accessible to exchange students. The contents can be found in our web page, under the banner [degrees awarded](#). The timetable can be found at [Check timetables](#). Some courses are offered in English, French or German (see attached file).

Exchange students can take courses from any of our degrees in the following fields:

- "Ingeniería Industrial": Mechanics, Electrical, Energetics, Design, Manufacturing, Hydraulics, Aeronautics ...
- Telecommunications: Electronics, Communications, and Telematics.
- Chemical Engineering: Environmental Technology, Industrial Chemistry.
- Industrial Organization Engineering: Economics and Engineering.
- Industrial Electronics and Automatic Control
- Materials Engineering.

Bachelor Project and Master Thesis can be performed at the Faculty in Spanish or English. The student must find a tutor through the International Office to be accepted.

GRADING SYSTEM

GRADE and **MARK** contain the result of the exam taken either on February (1st semester/Fall semester) or on June (2nd semester/Spring semester). In case there is no Mark and Grade says NOT TAKEN, that means that the student did not take the exam or failed it.

Languages	There are Spanish courses for exchange students . An intensive course in August-September (2 weeks), and regular courses during each semester. As we are a bilingual region, our courses are offered in Spanish and in Basque (in separate groups). There is the possibility of studying a course on Basque Language and Culture.

Acceptance package:	The students will receive the acceptance package two-three weeks after applications are received. The students coming from countries needing a VISA will receive the original acceptance letter sent from our office.

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ORIENTATION AND WELCOME

Our Faculty organizes the Buddy program. Every foreign student is assigned to one or two local students who will act as tutors before and after the arrival. The buddies will be in contact with the Exchange students by email before the semester starts, in order to know their arrival date.

Once exchange students arrive at Bilbao, they must submit a copy of their registration in their home Universities. In addition, on Thursday before each semester starts, there is a gathering and orientation meeting in our Faculty, and the students must to attend it. We will have the meeting on September and January, in room "Aula de Grados" (building A, 1st floor).
